

Absolute Value

Absolute value refers to the **distance between two numbers**. It is always a non-negative value (≥ 0) and is represented by 2 parallel lines or **bars (|)** around the number or expression.

Examples:

$$|9| = 9$$

$$|-7| = 7$$

$$|6 - 8| = |-2| = 2$$

$$|5 - 5| = |0| = 0$$
